

First Presbyterian Church Covington Youth Ministry Intern Job Description

Job Summary:

Part-time, non-ordained intern position responsible for planning, implementing, and overseeing ministries that will reach and nurture youth and their families at FPC Covington. Foster the development of a deep, personal, spiritual, and abiding relationship with Jesus Christ among youth ages to encourage the development of their relationships with God. Will serve as a spiritual leader and role model.

We are seeking a charismatic, high-energy intern to work with our youth and adhere to the following responsibilities:

- Our ideal candidate will be one who cannot only inspire our youth, but also their families, encouraging a connection with the church body through the many opportunities available.
- This person should feel the call to develop and grow a program with innovation and excitement, encouraging and teaching our youth with the love of God at this important time of spiritual growth.
- Work closely with youth to develop and encourage their growth as disciples of Jesus Christ through fellowship, service, study, and worship.
- Work closely and collaboratively with the Associate Pastor for Faith Formation. Reports to and meets regularly with the Associate Pastor to collaborate.
- Work with staff and ministry teams to identify, recruit, train and nurture volunteers and implement creative and meaningful Christian education for our youth.
- Plan and supervise youth program events, Bible studies, fellowship outings, and mission opportunities.
- Be comfortable with appropriate use of social media platforms and other means of communication.
- Be emotionally present with others and be intentional about sharing pastoral care needs as they arise with the Associate Pastor.
- Should be visible in the church and community, being able to communicate with youth, adult volunteers, and parents with an easy rapport.
- Support the mission and vision of FPC Covington: "FPC Covington is a Christian community existing to glorify God by welcoming all of God's children. We celebrate

through serving, teaching, praying, eating, crying, singing, and dancing with the Holy Spirit. As works in progress, we seek to respond to God's presence in our church, lives, and community."

- Will abide by the Child Protection Policy of First Presbyterian Church Covington.
- 8-10 hours per week:
 - Sunday mornings 9:30 am-12 pm (participate in Youth Sunday School, attend worship, interact with youth and their families)
 - Wednesdays 4:00-7:30 pm (plan, lead, and supervise youth program)
 - Once a month Sunday afternoon service outings with the youth
 - Once a month fellowship outings with the youth
 - o 5 hours of prep time/week
- Compensation: \$2,000 for the entire year or \$1,000 per semester
- Location: 45 minutes southeast of Atlanta
